2024 was a great year for EYC
Foundation. In January we rolled
out a shiny new website that helps
us spread the good news about the
positive impact we have on hundreds
of local diverse and underrepresented
youth.

In April the 13th Annual Marine & Maritime Career Expo happened with 9 attending high schools, over 120 students and dozens of exhibitors at the busy Bert Jabin Yacht Yard. Students connected with marine service and retail companies, trade schools and colleges, military and government representatives. Some even left with summer job offers!

In May the 9th Annual STEM on the Water program took place at EYC. We taught STEM principles by way of marine and maritime basics, and treated close to 100 fifth graders to an afternoon on a sail or powerboat. Dr Joanna Tobin of AACPS said "The EYCF maritime learning imprints lessons that simply can't be taught in the classroom".

In June we gave out Junior Sailing Scholarships for a week of sailing camp at EYC. Our newest rising star, Henry Reyes has completed three beginner and advanced classes and hopes to return this summer as an Instructor-in-Training.

## STEM

#### STEM on the Water

Our 9th Annual STEM on the Water hosted nearly 100 fifth graders from Eastport, Georgetown East, and Annapolis Elementary Schools at Eastport Yacht Club for three days of hands-on learning and adventure. Students rotated through interactive stations covering Tides, Wind, Navigation, Mechanical Advantage, and Ecosystem Health. They experimented with anemometers, compasses, navigation charts, and pulley systems while gaining insights into the science of sailing and the Chesapeake Bay's unique ecosystem. The day included sail and powerboat rides. Thanks to the efforts of EYCF volunteers, students left with new skills, lasting memories, and a deeper appreciation for the bay and the joys of being on the water.



## Marine & Maritime Career Expo

In April, EYCF's Marine & Maritime Career Expo hosted students from nine local high schools for a day of networking and exploring career opportunities with over 35 exhibitors including the Marine Trades Association of MD, Yacht Brokers of Annapolis, Electronic Marine Annapolis, and M Yacht Services The Expo was again held at Bert Jabin Yacht Yard in Annapolis allowing students to experience "a day in the life of the marine industry" at one of the area's busiest professional boat yards. Additionally, students toured businesses, had Q & A sessions with marine technicians, observed boats being launched, and found out about the history of the yard. Thanks to our volunteers, marine and maritime organizations, local businesses, schools, and sponsors, the event was a success. Students were excited to learn about the career possibilities in this thriving industry.



### Marine & Maritime Scholarships
